Implement the 2021–2022 COVID–19 Operational Guidelines.  Assist DPH with contact tracing, notify close contacts** by phone, and follow guidelines for modified quarantine*.  Close contacts at this level are individuals who are not wearing a face covering, or not fully vaccinated, and are within 3 feet of a positive case during the contagious period.  Modified Quarantine*  Option 1: Close contact will continue to attend school and wear a face covering for the duration of the quarantine period, as long as he/she remains asymptomatic;  —OR—  Option 2: Close contact will remain at home for the duration of the quarantine period.  NOTE: A modified quarantine is only allowed for students who are identified as a close contact within the school setting. This does not apply to a household or other outside exposure. Those individuals will be required to follow standard quarantine procedures, set forth by DPH.		Implement COVID-19 Operational Guidelines with the following enhancements:  Defined traffic patterns in hallways and other locations  Reduce the number of students eating in the cafeteria at one time by using classrooms and other designated locations  Changes in arrival procedures to limit the number of students in one location  No outside organizations in the buildings after school hours  Changes in format of club meetings, grade level meetings, etc. to accommodate smaller groups and increase physical distancing  Field trips will be limited  Parent meetings will be held virtually or at central office  Conduct contact tracing, notify close contacts** by phone, and follow guidelines for modified quarantine*.  Close contacts at this level are individuals who are not wearing a face covering, or not fully vaccinated, and are within 3 feet of a positive case during the contagious period.		<ul> <li>In addition to previous enhancements, additional mitigation measures will include the following:         <ul> <li>Essential visitor policy reviewed and revised as needed</li> <li>Student learning in alternate locations, including gymnasiums, media centers, and other large areas, as applicable</li> <li>Assigned seats on buses</li> <li>Pods of students to limit movement and reduce interaction with others</li> <li>Where applicable, recess and breaks in smaller groups</li> <li>Transition and movement of students in the buildings will be significantly reduced</li> <li>Field trips will be limited or restricted</li> </ul> </li> <li>Conduct contact tracing, notify close contacts** by phone, and follow guidelines for modified quarantine*.</li> <li>Close contacts at this level are individuals who are not wearing a face covering, or not fully vaccinated, and are within 6 feet of a positive case during the contagious period.</li> </ul>	

NOTE: In order for a school to move back to the previous level, the percent of students and staff with an active case must fall within the specific threshold for five (5) consecutive school days.

<sup>\*</sup>Modified Quarantine, as allowed by the Georgia Department of Public Health, is used in order to preserve in-person instruction for healthy students.

\*\*Individuals wearing a mask will not be considered a close contact at any distance. Fully vaccinated individuals will not be considered a close contact at any time.
